



SUN-PROTECTION PRODUCT DEVELOPERS TREK BRECON BEACONS FOR SKIN CANCER RESEARCH

First-time trekkers, Team LLumar are taking on 29 miles of the Brecon Beacons for the **British Skin Foundation**. Team members Aaron, Andy, Mel, Paul & Rachel from **Cosham, near Portsmouth** are trying to raise at least £1,000 to go towards vital skin cancer research.

The team, aged from 29 to 47, were inspired to fundraise for the British Skin Foundation after working with them in a professional capacity on the **LLumar AU 85** – a virtually transparent film which is applied to car windows to protect those inside from the harmful effects of the sun including harmful UVAs.

Mel Knight from Team LLumar explains *“We are very grateful to the British Skin Foundation for having recognised the potential of LLumar AU 85 in terms of protecting people’s skin from the sun’s harmful rays, and we wanted to give them something back! This is why we decided to trek the Brecon Beacons!”*
